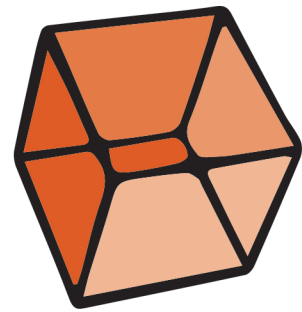


things to remember when...

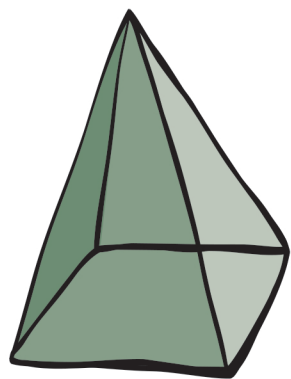
Completing a module

+ The **Learning Map** is where we choose something new to **learn that we're ready for**.



+ Each gem is a **key concept**, made up of a collection of **modules**.

+ The modules that you **already know** are coloured gold, and the ones you're **ready to learn** are coloured blue.



+ Once you've chosen a module, we complete it by **answering questions** in our maths **exercise books**.

+ **Don't skip** any questions.

+ Correct your work **as you go**, one question at a time, using the **'check my answer' button**.

+ The **"Help"** button is useful when you're **stuck**.

+ The **"Stop"** button is useful when you think this **module isn't right for you** – it might be too easy if you made too many mistakes in the diagnostic, and this button lets you fix this.

+ We click the **"Finish"** button only once we're confident that we have **learned the mathematics properly**.
